State Route 99 Southbound Full Closure and Detour Between Kansas Avenue Off-Ramp & H Street On-Ramp

Location: Southbound State Route 99 Between Kansas Avenue & H Street On-Ramp

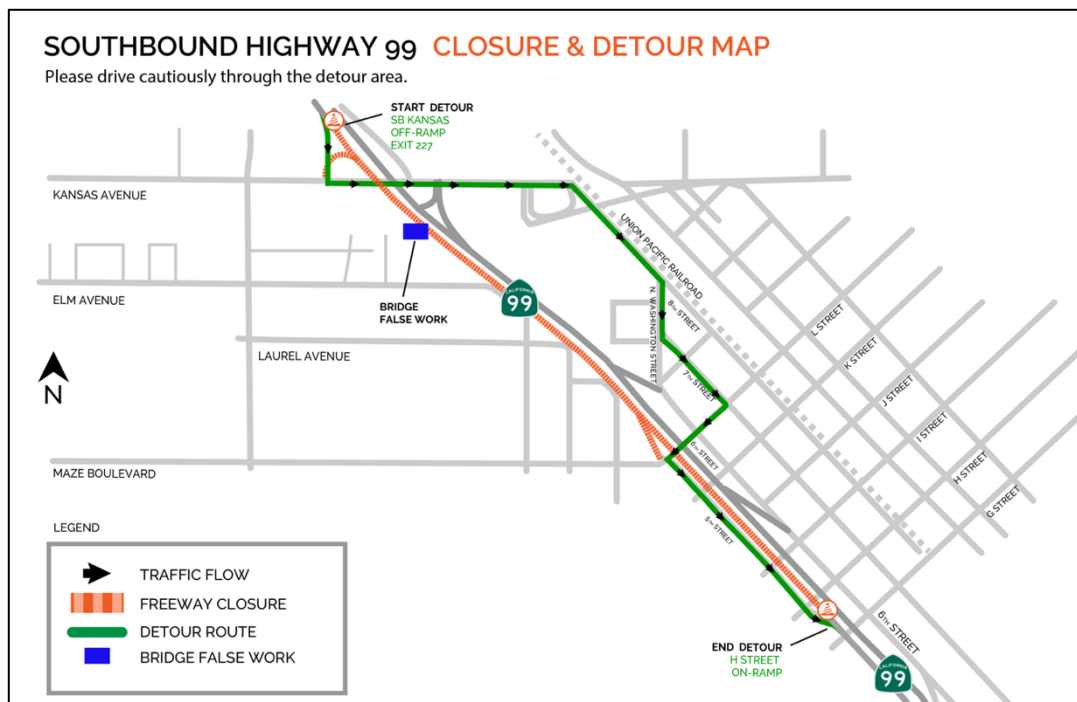
This closure is subject to change due to weather and other unforeseen circumstances.

The SR 132 project team would like to give you advance notice that from March through early April, between the hours of 11 pm and 5 am Monday through Thursday, Southbound State Route 99 will have a full closure and detour between the Southbound Kansas Avenue off-ramp and the H Street Southbound on-ramp. This closure and detour will only be in effect during nighttime hours and is expected to be repeated intermittently, over the course of multiple nights. Crews will be erecting falsework over State Route 99 to construct the new State Route 132 separation bridge that will span over State Route 99. Once specific dates of the closures have been finalized, an updated traffic alert will be issued.

Southbound State Route 99 travelers will be directed to exit State Route 99 at Kansas Avenue via ramp exit 227. Travelers will then be detoured back onto the highway using City surface streets to the H Street on-ramp, as shown on the map below. Detour signs and flaggers will be posted along the detour route for positive guidance during the closure.

Northbound will also have a full closure; however, it will not be concurrent with the Southbound full closure.

The green outline in the graphic below illustrates the detour route for the Southbound Highway 99 closure. The project team thanks you for your patience and for driving cautiously through the construction areas.
